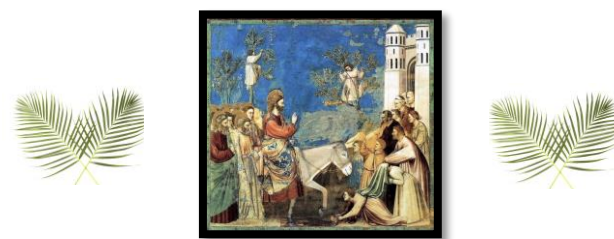

PALMS IN JERUSALEM -
PALMS IN HEAVENS.-.-

" When Jesus entered Jerusalem a very large crowd cut branches from the palms and spread them on the road " (Matthew 21) and " I saw a great multitude in heaven holding palm branches in their hands " (Revelation 7)

And today exactly the same " very large crowds " and " a great multitude " celebrate and rejoice in the resurrection of Our Lord Jesus Christ , who conquered a victory for us with suffering beyond all telling .

The people who were crying and saying : " Hossana to the Son of David , blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord " (Matthew 21) soon will be crying and saying " crucify him , crucify him " (Luke 23) so Palm Sunday has that bittersweet taste praises and betrayal from the people of Jerusalem.....and how are we ? faithful or unfaithful to our dear Lord in his sorrowful moments..... entering soon into his passion and death , but we know that " love is stronger " (St. John Paul II) .
