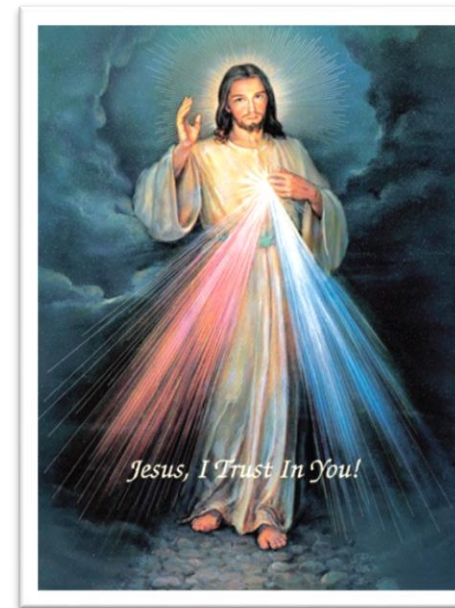

Mary , Mother of the Risen Christ , pray for us Blessings from Fr. Jaime

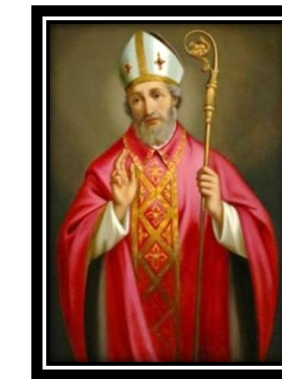
UPCOMING MINISTRY MEETING:
