shown mercy " (Matthew 5) .

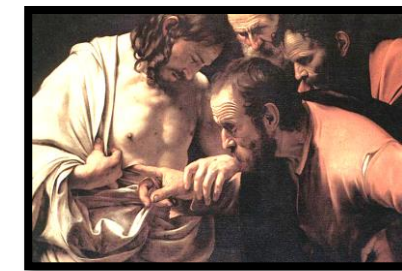
We repeat and repeat untiringly " have
