NEXT SUNDAY'S READINGS:

ADMIRABLE CLARE .-

In this 19th Sunday of Ordinary Time (Jesus in the mission) the readings offer us words like : " our fathers ...their faith....courage...salvation of the justthe holy children of the good (the saints) ...divine institution (meaning : hymns of praise ; hymns of our fathers)little flocksell your belongingstreasure in heavenservants and more....

All these words in the readings inviting us to belong to the little flock of the Lord , rejecting evil and its works as was admirably done by the saint of this week St. Clare of Assisi (Italy 1194 - 1253) , but also going back to our roots , to all those who are our fathers and mothers in faith , those who are living witnesses teaching us that holiness is possible :

" be holy , because I am holy "

(1 Peter 1)

What we have today in our Catholic Church is because we have a solid foundation starting with Abraham and all his descendants in faith and holy lives. St. Clare , her great emphasis was on gospel poverty as Jesus himself stressed it :

" Blessed you who are poor , for yours is the kingdom of God " (Luke 6)

and St. Clare embodied in her own life the same predilection of Jesus : the poor.

What do we do for the poor , the needy , the brokenhearted ...?

Mary , Mother of the Redeemer , pray for us .
