TEARS OF CONVERSION .-

The readings of this 21st Sunday are beautiful, meaningful and illuminating, in the second reading we find words of wisdom that illuminate the week "strengthen your drooping hands and your weak knees; make straight paths for your feet that what is lame not be disjointed but healed" (Hebrew 12) and these words apply perfectly with the life of a man from Africa from the 4th century, his name was Augustine and his life was "drooping, weak and disjointed" and certainly he was not in "the right path", offending God, the neighbor and himself; but he was so fortunate to have a mother like Monica, who was not only praying constantly for Augustine's conversion, but shedding tears of sorrow and hope.... in those times the Bishop Ambrose told Monica:

"it cannot be that the son of those tears should perish"....prophetic words from a holy man, St. Ambrose, who after Augustine's conversion became his spiritual director.... so now Augustine is strong, healed and in the right path not only for himself, but giving testimony of Jesus Christ in the most outstanding ways. The prayers and tears of his mother Monica gained for Augustine his conversion; all of them are St. Monica, St. Augustine (their feasts August 27 and 28) and St. Ambrose.....our fathers in faith.

Nowadays there are many, many mothers praying and crying for their children for their conversion, for their return to the righteousness and decency and to be away from sin and darkness.

Mother Mary, Refuge of Sinners, pray for us.
