TRANSFIGURATION OF THE LORD

MASTER OF MIGHT .-

The book of Wisdom in chapter 12
describes God as “ the master of might ” ,
words that are so sublime and almost
impossible to translate for the intensity of
its meaning but we humbly approach to
those realms of divinity and spiritual life . We
have the help of the Holy Scripture , source
of eternal wisdom , as in the book of Job
when he is arguing with God and God tells
him : “ have you an arm like that of God
or can you thunder with a voice like him ? ”
or the names given to God like Omnipotent ,
Almighty , Omnipresent and the name of the
Archangel St. Michael :

“ Who is like God ? ” and when we pray
the Creed “ I believe in God the Father
Almighty , Creator of heaven and earth.....”

everlasting and beyond telling , impossible to
be defined by human words , always will we
miss something , but He the infinite and
unapproachable God made himself
approachable in Our Lord Jesus Christ who

Galilee , Samaria and Judea performing
miracles .
