THE TRUE AIM OF LIFE .-

We live in a constant duality as if we had two layers in our person, a duplicity that brings a lot of complications in our lives. Our mind is not easy, impossible to grasp, because it is internal. The more simple we are, the more happy we are; the more complicated we are, the more distressed we are, meaning anxious and restless. That is the reason that Jesus said: "let the children come to me, for the kingdom of God belongs to such as these" (Matthew 19) or "I give praise to you Father, for you have revealed these things to the childlike" (Matthew 11).

"our chief, in fact our only task, is to get rid of the double garment, the overlaying layer of duplicity that is not ourselves" (Thomas Merton), meaning that our chief task is on finding our true self, not that overplayed by society, wrong ideas, ignorance and more ... like returning to the moment we were created by God.
