JESUS AND THE TWELVE I

Jesus said to the Twelve :

" blessed are your eyes because they see , and your ears , because they hear . Amen , I say to you , many prophets and righteous people longed to see what you see , but did not see it , and to hear what you hear , but did not hear it " (Matthew 13)

Jesus knowing that his time on earth was brief " went up the mountain and summoned those whom he wanted and they came to him . He appointed twelve , whom he also named apostles , that they might be with him and might send them forth to preach and to have authority to drive out demons " (Mark 3)and he assured them this : " I have called you friends , because I have told you everything I have heard from my Father " (John 15)
