### LENTEN SEASON PRACTICES .-

Our Catholic Church teaches:

" every person 14 years of age or older must abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all the Fridays of Lent "

that is ABSTINENCE ..... but also: "every person between 18 and 59 years old must fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday ", that is FASTING.

With these two practices the invitation is clear : sacrifice - discipline - penance .

These practices help you to enter in the discipline of self-control in every aspect of our ives. Sacrifice gives you a very special joy, because is gets you closer to the reason of our joy: Jesus Christ, whose sacrifice on the cross is the salvation of the world.

Remembering the words of St. Paul: "whatever you do, in word or deed, do it all, in the name of the Lord Jesus "

(Colossians 3)

God wants us to be immersed in this Lent, but He wants you to abstain, fast or sacrifice with pure love which will return to you in abounding blessings.
