" whoever loves me will keep my word and my Father will love him , and we will come to him and make our dwelling with him " ( John 14 )

The impact of the Emmanuel of Bethlehem continues bringing so much joy to the faithful for the closeness of the Lord to his people , but not like multitudes without faces , rather God's love for everyone in a personal way ....so close to us ...after the coming of the Messiah is not God and us or God in heavens and we on earth , now is God with us ...." and the Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us " ( John 1 ) .
