OUR LADY OF FATIMA: Remembering the 100 year anniversary of the apparitions of Our Lady of Fatima in Portugal, the Most Rev. Robert Guglielmone, has declared all churches within the diocese bearing a title of the Blessed Mother to be a pilgrim site from May 13th-Dec. 12th. Pope Francis has granted a plenary indulgence opportunity to those who pray before any statue of Our Lady of Fatima "*solemnly exposed for public veneration in any church, oratory or proper place during the days of the anniversary of the apparitions*" on the 13th of each month from May-Oct. 2017, participating in special prayer services to honor Our Blessed Mother. Those seeking an indulgence must also pray an Our Father, recite the Creed & invoke Our Lady of Fatima.

MATTHEW 11.-
