PROSPERITY OVER JERUSALEM .-

Words mentioned in the first reading (Isaiah 66) of this 14th Sunday of Ordinary Time that invite us to study more about Jerusalem (also named in different ways along the centuries) : Rusalimum , Urusalim , Ursalimmu , Salem , Shalom , City of David , Jebus , Zionand jumping in time we come to the days of King David (1000 bc) who brought the Ark of the Covenant (symbol of the presence of God) to Jerusalem , at the beginning the Ark was left in the house of Obed who received abounding blessings and then was put in a tent for adoration ; later when Solomon built the temple of Jerusalem (960 bc) the Ark was brought into the temple , so the temple was full of the glory of God and became the only temple in the whole nation of Israel where the true and living God was adored and worshiped .

Some stages of the city of Jerusalem :

- a big city in the southern area of Israel (Judea)
- a city where was built the Temple of Jerusalem , solemn emblem of Yahweh .
- a city visited so many times by Jesus , described in the Gospels .
- the heavenly Jerusalem (Revelation 21)

All those symbols of the Catholic Church , prosperity over our Church in all generations ; prosperity brought to her by her holy ones , precious pearls of the Church .

At Blessed Trinity we have prosperity because of our little ones , prayerful , faithful and humble.
