FIREARMS POLICY: In 2005, Bishop Robert J. Baker released a policy regarding firerams on Diocesan propery. Bishop Robert E. Guglielmone has not chosen to reverse this policy & continues to support it: *“The possession of firearms or other dangerous weapons on or in Diocesan property, except by authorized security officials, is expressly forbidden. Concealed weapons are not permitted at any time on any Diocesan property. Diocesan property includes but is not limited to buildings, parking areas, churches, schools, playgrounds, offices, gymnasiums, and sporting events.”* Regardless of a permit and/or training to carry a firearm or other concealed weapon, as Catholics we have the moral obligation to obediently follow our bishop’s lead in this matter.

SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

DANIEL 7 :

As the visions of the night continued , I saw “ One like a son of man coming on the clouds of heaven” (Daniel 7 , 13)

Some weeks ago we contemplated Jesus ascending to heaven in the presence of the Apostles , now we go back to the Old Testament in a so meaningful and important prophecy from the Prophet Daniel , that will be fulfilled in the Incarnation and Nativity of the Divine Word , Jesus , our Savior and Redeemer . He is the Son of Man, God made flesh , God born of a woman , the great and loving mystery of the person of Jesus , who is the center of our faith .

He wants to stress this decisive prophecy of Daniel ; constantly in the Gospels He is naming himself as the Son of Man , for example :

“ For the Son of Man did not come to be served , but to serve ” (Mark 10)

and *“ that you may know that the Son of Man has authority ...” (Luke 5)*

Jesus wants to teach us that He is the Son of Mary , Son of Joseph , Son of our Fathers in faith , Son of the mankind.

This is what the prophet Daniel foresaw .

“ O Lord , how admirable is your name through all the earth..!” (Psalm 8)
