FIREARMS POLICY: In 2005, Bishop Robert J. Baker released a policy regarding firerams on Diocesan property. Bishop Robert E. Guglielmone has not chosen to reverse this policy & continues to support it: *"The possession of firearms or other dangerous weapons on or in Diocesan property, except by authorized security officials, is expressly forbidden. Concealed weapons are not permitted at any time on any Diocesan property. Diocesan property includes but is not limited to buildings, parking areas, churches, schools, playgrounds, offices, gymnasiums, and sporting events."*

Regardless of a permit and/or training to carry a firearm or other concealed weapon, as Catholics we have the moral obligation to obediently follow
