CORPUS CHRISTI .-

Jesus said to his disciples :

" I am the bread of life " (John 6) and soon many of disciples left him , because they couldn't cope with the mystery that those words involve , but Simon Peter and the other apostles they remained faithful and stayed with him

" Master , to whom we shall go ? You have words of eternal life " (John 6)

J.M. Talbot composed a beautiful song dedicated to the Eucharist :

" you satisfy the hungry heart with gift of finest wheat " and he was really inspired , because it is a powerful message for today , but at the same time taking us to the times of Moses and the manna I in the desert (Exodus 16) in the same way God satisfies our hungry hearts with the bread of life , Jesus , really present in the consecrated host and wine : His body and bloodsacrament of salvation .

In the Sequence of Corpus Christi : we read " what he did at supper seated , Christ ordained to be repeated , his memorial never to cease " . We , priests tremble before such loving and powerful words " Do this in memory of me " .

The Eucharist is the center of our faith , the altar is a wellspring of blessings .

Every time we gather around the altar to celebrate the Holy Mass it is a piece of heaven on earth .
