MINISTRY OF RECONCILIATION .-

What Jesus saw in his public ministry by GalileeJews against Romans , Romans against Jews , Jews against Jews , families against families.....and he thought that reconciliation was a priority : " he might reconcile both of them (the divided groups) in one body to God through the cross " (Ephesians 2) ...yes , the cross is made of two pieces of wood , one vertical and one horizontal , pointing to heaven and to earth ...the point of union to all kind of division and antagonism ; enemies come together in the cross .

Also , reconciliation has two parts that instead of being united are dispersed . The Sacrament of Confession also is called the Sacrament of Reconciliation , because when you confess your sins and receive the absolution from the priest you are reconciled with God, with your neighbor and with yourself. Then we go into the world , the daily life and we break this reconciliation , we need to seek the unity again , the reconciliation , the peace , the inner joy , the stability .

St. Paul teaches us : "God reconciled us to himself through Christ entrusting to us the ministry of reconciliation , we implore you on behalf of Christ , be reconciled to God." (2 Corinthians 5) .

Mary , Mother of Unity , pray for us.
