### THE TWO WIDOWS .-

This beautiful 32h Sunday offers us precious pearls , the stories of the two widows : one who was contemporaneous to the prophet Elijah ( 900 BC ) and the second one is contemporaneous to Jesus ; in both women their faith and generosity are exalted as an outstanding example for all generations , they knew that the Lord always provides , they relied on him and not in the mere situation they are in ; they knew , as all men and women of faith should know , that after the darkest clouds the sun will shine again , they had hope and it moved them to give without calculating . What lessons for us !!

One widow lived in Zarephath ( town out of Israel ) and the other one somewhere in Israel ; the first one pagan the second one Jewish ; the women of peace and hope that are inviting us to live in God , not only in material things , but always willing to share , to give , to become missionaries of Divine Providence . They also teach us to celebrate with joy the coming feasts of Christ the King and to live with love and simplicity the Advent season soon to come and then rejoice in the Emmanuel . The two widows teach us not be indifferent , but caring & alert . One was close to a man of God , the prophet Elijah , the second one with God himself: Jesus Christ who saw her and her frugal coins and was touched by her generosity & self-detachment. Admirable widows , you belong with us now that know better .
