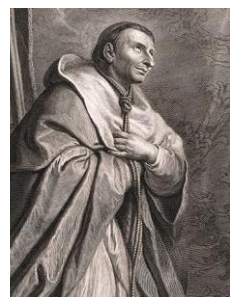

KAIROS TEAM VOLUNTEERING will be visiting *Perry Correctional Institution* the weekend of November 8-11. During the weekend, the Ministry Team will present a short course on Christianity to 24-30 prisoners selected by the warden, and distribute cookies each day to over 1,000 inmates in the prison. One volunteer from Blessed Trinity is responsible for providing 75 dozen cookies. If you think you might be able to help in either making or purchasing cookies (chocolate chip, oatmeal, peanut butter, molasses, ginger or sugar cookies between 2"-2 1/2" in diameter, not more than 1/2" thick, and must not contain fruit or nuts nor be covered by sugar or icing), please contact Mr. Tom Kenny (864.498.2319). Please layer them in boxes to prevent breakage and indicate the number of cookies packed on the outside of the box (*No plastic bags please*).
