### CULMINATION and NEW BEGINNING.-

In Mark 1 we read : " when the time has come" and in Galatians 4: " when the set time had fully come" , both messages meaning when the right time came according to God's will . The same happens today when we are moving forward quickly to the end of the year and special things are coming like the Solemnity of Christ the King that is the threshold for the coming Advent season ; so it is the culmination of a season and the beginning of a new season .

For example , nine months of pregnancy that comes to the end when the baby is born and here comes the beginning of a new life being a mother of the baby. Or 9 years in the Seminary and when the priestly ordination comes is the culmination of that life as a seminarian and the beginning of priestly ministry.
