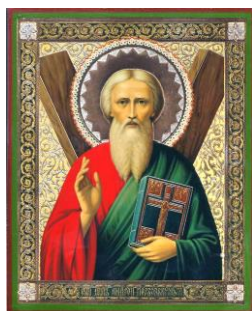

## CHRIST THE KING . . .

In Mexico there was a secularist government ( 1927) who was absolutely enemy of the Catholic Church and persecuted the clergy and the faithful , killing thousands . One of them was the Blessed Father Miguel Pro , a Jesuit priest who was accused falsely of acts of violence ; he was put in prison and condemned to death ; when he was about to be executed he exclaimed :

HAIL CHRIST THE KING ..! and died as a martyr of our Church.

This holy priest was freely consecrated to Christ the King and not to human kings ( as in his case , the president Plutarco , the leader of the persecutors of the Church in those days in Mexico .

Was Jesus a king ? The answer is coming from John 6 when after the multiplication of loaves , Jesus knew that they were going to make him king , he withdrew again to the mountain alone .....and when Pilate asked him “ then are you king ? , Jesus answered : you say I am a king ” and also “ my kingdom does not belong to this world ” ( John 18).

Our King Jesus has a crown of thorns and was born in a simple manger and in a very unknown village : Bethlehem ; he loves humility , simplicity and the little ones.
