LITTLE SAND.....COUNTLESS RICHES.-

This 28th Sunday of Ordinary Time is illuminated by the first reading, that is like a beacon of light in the middle of darkness or errors, it is Wisdom 7.....and goes like this:

"because all gold, in view of wisdom is a little sandand because the splendor of wisdom never yields to sleep and countless riches at her hands".

We can link these rich words with the story of the lame beggar and the apostles Simon Peter and John, all in the context of the temple of Jerusalem, Simon told the beggar: "Silver or gold I do not have, but what I do have I give you, in the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, walk.." (Acts 3) ...what did Simon give the lame beggar? his most precious gift, the wisdom of faith that is unbreakable, powerful and flows infinite love.

So, if we devoutly dedicate ourselves to cultivate wisdom in our lives, an immense peace will come upon us, notoriously, joyfully and uplifting, like a new life in Christ.

In the story of the Gospel of this Sunday (Mark 10), that man couldn't give up his possessions and lost the richness of the Lord for his lack of wisdom.
