28TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME PRIESTHOOD .

We Catholics have seen from our childhood priests of all kinds and ages, the priest of our Baptism, the priest of our Parish in our town, priests in Catholic schools, hospitals and etc...

All those multitudes of priests and the priests of today all come from Jesus Christ, the High and Eternal Priest who gave his gift to one of the Twelve tribes of Israel, the tribe of Levi, they had the blessing of the priesthood, they were the priests of the Old Covenant and those who confronted Jesus in his days in Israel.
