They are our faithful heavenly companions , protection , inspiration and light in the darkness of this world .

An ancient prayer to the Guardian Angel says :

" Dear Guardian Angel ever at my side , how loving must thou be " and certainly this angelic creature is loving , because he is constantly serving the Almighty God who is eternal love , fire of charity . The guardian angel is always at our side....our faithful companion . The one who rejoices when we overcome temptations and is sad when we fail .
