DELIBERATION OF MORTALS .-

A description of what a mortal is : " emptiness , desolation , waste , melting hearts and trembling knees ; writhing in every frame , every face blanched " (Nahum 2) a very nihilist (pessimistic) description , but in thousands & thousands of cases absolutely true and rooted in reality , the human drama , where despair , uncertainty and darkness are highly present in the life of many as it is expressed clear and strong in the psalm : " why are you downcast , my soul ; why do you groan within me ? . Wait for God , whom I shall praise again , my savior and my God " (Psalm 42) ..the key words of these verses are : downcast , groan , soul and again ; they show the ups and downs of human nature , always restless , falling and rising , but to those who believe there will always be hope..... ; but to those who haven't found a powerful hand to cling totheir rumination is weak , poor , conditioned and before them brooding horizons. Jesus said " because without me you can do nothing " (John 15)

The incarnation of Jesus is God becoming mortal , Jesus died on the cross

He is true God and true man and as a man he met multitudes of men and women in Israel with their miseries , concerns and very poor ability for deliberation ; better to do things than give thoughts to reality ; Jesus knowing all that was instilling in them wisdom and giving them solid foundations : how could a thing remain , unless you willed it ; or be preserved , had it not been called forth by you ? " (Wisdom 12) .
